Soft 'n Sheer *Extra*™

1. Use as a Stabilizer Backing for Machine Embroidery, Appliqué Monogramming, Hand-work and more...

by ironing Soft 'n Sheer Extra to the wrong side of the fabric. A knit almost behaves like a stable woven fabric, and woven fabrics become even more manageable. Soft 'n Sheer Extra removes any stretch or play in the fabric, resulting in better end results whatever the project. Cut a piece of Soft 'n Sheer Extra slightly larger than your hoop for computerized embroidery, or slightly larger than your design area for hand or free-motion work, and iron it onto the wrong side of your fabric, using a low/medium temperature steam-iron (about 260°). Ideal for woven or knit fabrics, and perfect for sheer fabrics when Soft 'n Sheer Extra is trimmed away close to stitching.

2. Removal is Easy...


once the stitching is completed, remove from the hoop, and if you want to remove the excess, lightly press once more with a medium temperature iron, and gently pull the excess away from the fabric. Then, using a pinking shears, trim close to the outer edge of the stitching.

3. Soft 'n Sheer Extra...

remains under the stitching to act as a support through laundering and wearing.

Note: Soft 'n Sheer Extra is a nylon product and will not tolerate a hot iron. Use a low temperature and/or a press cloth when ironing, or press from the fabric side only.

General Information-

1. **Sulky Fusible Soft 'n Sheer Extra** is a texturized, non-woven, cut-away nylon that is ideal for dense embroidery designs, open-weave fabrics, or complex designs on lightweight knits and wovens. Soft 'n Sheer Extra is less noticeable under more transparent fabrics. The uniqueness of this fusible version makes this product a staple in your embroidery stabilizer collection. By fusing the stabilizer onto the back of the garment, you will be more successful in hooping, and you will not stretch the garment out of shape.
2. **Sulky Soft 'n Sheer Extra** is 1-1/2 times as heavy as original Soft 'n Sheer, with the added convenience of having a fusible, iron-on backing.
3. With excellent stretch resistance, **Soft 'n Sheer Extra** eliminates pulling or sagging from the surrounding fabric not only during the stitching process, but during washing and wearing. **IT WILL NOT TEAR AWAY** like most other Sulky Stabilizers. It is permanent through washings, acting as a **permanent support for the thread**.
4. Fusible Soft 'n Sheer Extra is ultra-soft next to the skin.
5. Be flexible and experiment with different combinations on different weights of fabric. Use one to two layers of Soft 'n Sheer Extra depending on the type of fabric and density of the stitching.

To get great results when you use Sulky Fusible Soft 'n Sheer Extra for Computerized Embroidery and Applique Work:

- Cut one or two pieces of Soft 'n Sheer Extra at least one inch larger all around than the hoop size you are planning to use.
- Fuse one or both pieces onto the back of the fabric using an iron set on a low to medium temp (260°F, silk setting). A press cloth may be used.
- Hoop the fabric and place the embroidery frame on the machine.

- Complete the layout and centering of the design. Use Sulky Decorative Threads to embroider your chosen design. Important! If the design is dense and/or poorly digitized (i.e., too many stitches for the design's size), for additional support, place one or two layers of Sulky Tear-Easy Stabilizer between the hoop and the bed of the machine.
- After the design is completed, clip the loose bobbin threads, then tear away the Tear-Easy one layer at a time, if you used it.
- Remove the fabric from the embroidery hoop.
- To remove any excess Soft 'n Sheer Extra, re-heat it and peel it back gently to the design; use pinking sheers to carefully cut away the excess without cutting the fabric it is stabilizing. (Removal of the excess is not recommended on fleece.)

Note: If embroidering a knit, to keep the stitches from sinking into the knit, use a Sulky Solvy or Heat-Away Clear Film topper!

Other Uses-

Also ideal for trapunto, for lining pillows, and for backing fabrics that tend to get caught on or in the throat plate of the machine while free-motion stitching. It can also be used to interface collars and facings
